Overview and Notes

During Winter and Summer 2022, the UASU Department of Research and Advocacy reviewed all known lists of past UASU Executives, including UASU records and University publications.

Due to significant gaps and conflicts, the Department developed a new list from primary sources (e.g. the archives of The Gateway, primarily election results, and the UASU's Evergreen and Gold yearbook), as found in Peel's Prairie Provinces and the Internet Archive. The final list resolves virtually all gaps; it establishes 478 unique individuals who have served on UASU Executive teams. Over 50 Executives listed in **bold** served in multiple roles and/or years. (For example, two known Executives have served three terms: Garett Poston (VP Academic 94-95, President 95-97) and Christian Fotang (VP External 21-23, President 23-24).)

Developing a comprehensive list from primary sources has had substantial benefits, like supporting memorial efforts for notable past Executives like Violet King Henry, and enabling quantitative assessments of gender representation in student leadership in the Identity Matters reports.

The citations listed in this document under the 'Sources' columns are only the few that establish the office they held.

Notes on Later Life

- Based on public information, a few notes on later life are included for interest. They are far from complete, and privacy considerations were applied, particularly for recent years.
- In many cases in the early 20th century, women's name changes (and, often, the end of their professional careers) when they married have made their later lives difficult to track. We hope that these blank places will not be taken as devaluing or disregarding their lives and accomplishments.
- The only historical notes included had a strong likelihood of pertaining to the correct individual. Any corrections or additional sources can be directed to <u>dra@uasu.ca</u> and are gratefully received.

Agnes Wilson, recruited out of 11th grade like some other women in the University's inaugural cohort, was 16 or 17 when she served as the UASU's first Vice President.² Like other former UASU VPs, she would go on to volunteer with the Soldiers' Comforts Club, coordinating care packages for First World War servicemen overseas. She also served overseas herself as a wartime nurse.

It is not clear whether there was a Vice President in 1909/10 and 1910/11; if so, it might have been Mary Elizabeth Lloyd or Ethel Anderson, who sat alongside Agnes Wilson on the first Students' Council in 1908/09. Lloyd, like Wilson, served as President of the Wauneitas Society, the independent society of women students. The Wauneitas did not get Students' Council representation until 1918 and did not formally become part of the UASU until 1929, but some individuals held top leadership roles in both organizations concurrently.

A.L. Carr is believed to be the first Executive with a disability; he had recently spent much of a semester hospitalized with a serious case of typhoid that appears to have impacted his health for years. While Carr was likely the first disabled Executive, he was by no means the last. Several later Executives were First World War veterans who had sustained serious injuries, for example.

Katherine McCrimmon, the first woman to serve as UASU President, may have also been the first Executive to establish a substantial governmental advocacy role for the UASU. Only weeks after taking office, while hosting a dinner for the President of the University and the Premier of Alberta, she advocated for women's inclusion in the University's academic governance and Board of Governors. (See The Gateway, 1917/02/20.)

McCrimmon went on to be the first woman on the predecessor to the General Faculties Council. Long after her death at the age of 35, <u>a tribute profile</u> in the Edmonton Journal (1990/05/27) spotlighted McCrimmon's wide-ranging contributions to Alberta public life:

...Until recently, Katie McCrimmon Love was something of an unsung hero. Born Feb 23, 1895, she died March 7, 1930, of a blood clot three weeks after giving birth to the last of her three daughters.

It wasn't until 1988 that the Edmonton Historical Board honored her for her contribution to social services in Alberta. Two weeks ago, the YWCA dedicated its annual Tribute to Women awards dinner in her memory.

...In 1916 she became the first woman president of the University of Alberta students' union — the first woman in Canada to hold that post.

...After graduating with a bachelor of arts degree in the class of 1917, Love taught summer schools at Viking, Irricano, and Cornforth.

She became the girls work secretary with the YWCA "which post she occupied with greatest benefit to all with whom she came in contact," said an obituary under the headline "Death of Katie McCrimmon Love Shock to Whole of Alberta."

After being contacted by an Ontario organization about a special program for teenage girls, Love became a founder of Canadian Girls in Training, an organization dedicated to give high ideals to inspire young girls and teenagers. [CGIT, a comparator to the Girl Scouts, still exists.]

Love married farmer and Wainwright MLA Russell Love in 1925. Her husband went on to become the provincial treasurer...The CGIT girls came out in the hundreds to her wedding...

Love went on to become the first woman and first alumna appointed to the university Senate [the forerunner of our General Faculties Council] in 1929.

War impacted many previous student leaders during and after their terms, but in 1919/20, most of the UASU leaders were already veterans. <u>Charles Reilly</u>, <u>James Lang</u>, and <u>Bob Lamb</u> had been wounded (at Ypres, the Somme, and Passchendaele, respectively), and Michener had briefly served as a RAF pilot. Other survivors of the First World War would enter student leadership in the 1920s.

Mark Marshall, born Mark Levey, had extraordinary careers both <u>before</u> and <u>after</u> his term as UASU President, which he served in his early 30s. Marshall was the first known UASU Executive of Jewish heritage, but changed his name in the 1940s and self-reported as Presbyterian when he joined the military.

A profile in *Heritage: The Journal of the Jewish Archives & Historical Society of Edmonton & Northern Alberta* (Summer 2009) offers context: "In the Faculty of Medicine, it took many years before Jewish staff could practice at the University Hospital. Dr. Mark Levey, who was likely the first appointment in 1931, changed his last name to Marshall and did not identify with his Jewish heritage...The Jewish community was also familiar with many other faculty members who for variable reasons did not identify or admit their faith..."

<u>A 1988 profile</u> in the Canadian Medical Association Journal lays out Anna Wilson's remarkable life, including her efforts to pursue training as a pediatric surgeon and obstetrician, her work during the Second World War, and extensive involvement in the immunizations that eliminated polio in Canada, for which she earned the Order of Canada. She also campaigned successfully for the construction of the Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario and the fluoridation of Ottawa's water. She remained a practicing physician well into her 80s.

The UASU's Evergreen and Gold yearbook noted: "The 1942-43 Students' Council experienced one of the most difficult years yet faced by the student executive. Not only was the effect of the war felt very acutely by every organization and individual on the campus; but also the Council had the unusual misfortune of losing the very efficient leadership of their President, Lloyd Grisdale." The Executive team saw three vacancies in this year, likely related to wartime service.

Doris Thompson took on the position of Vice President mid-year and then needed to lead a diminished Executive team. From there, she faced additional challenges as one of only two women who graduated from the accounting program. In a <u>2010 interview</u> with the Alberta School of Business, Thompson — then almost 90 years old — recalled: "I was naive back in 1940...I didn't know that accounting firms in Alberta did not hire women graduates. Hence the silent quota at the university." But at the height of the Second World War, the federal government began interviewing women for certain jobs, and Doris secured a career with the Ministry of Finance.

Burns' <u>obituary</u> notes: "In 1954, he was elected the first full-time paid President of the National Federation of Canadian University Students petitioning the federal government for post-secondary student scholarships which ultimately led to a federal program of student financial aid."

In the early 1960s, Jackson was <u>Chair</u> of Alberta's Advisory Board on Objectionable Publications, a censorship body which focused on children's access to material on newsstands and in comics. However, the board's role started to become more repressive and far-reaching, an escalation that impacted publishing in Alberta for a decade, and Jackson resigned over freedom of expression.
