Vacancy Process

Vacancy petitions fill vacant seats on Students' Council and General Faculties Council. The petition process is explained in <u>Regulation 110.06: Students' Council and GFC Replenishment</u>. When there are more petitions than vacancies, the petitions with the most student signatures are successful.

Petitions Received

Vacancy petitions for the two empty Science seats on Students' Council were received from April 5th to April 12th. Three complete petitions were filed.
