Welcome back to the University of Alberta! **You are the expert—show off your campus!**

Campus Ambassadors is a great way to get involved in campus life and to meet other University students just like you. If you feel a strong sense of pride for the U of A and have a strong desire to help introduce prospective students or the general public to our campus and facilities, then you are exactly who our program is looking for!

Campus Ambassadors will be recruiting for 2 programs this Winter 2010 semester: **Campus Tours**, and our student-for-a-day program, **FYI: The First Year Initiative**. Here's some information on each program:

Campus Tours: The objective of the program is to provide tours of the University's main campus to prospective students, school groups, alumni, VIPs, and the general public. Each tour will last for approximately an hour. Volunteers for this program can expect to give about one tour per week. Each volunteer is required to sign up for specific time slots each semester, depending on their availability. Time commitment is absolutely flexible.

FYI: The First Year Initiative: This is the University of Alberta's student-for-a-day program. Volunteers for this program will act as mentors and will take participants to classes (your classes), go to lunch with them and possibly give them a tour of campus, and take them to an advisory session. FYI mentors can expect to volunteer for about two days per month.

As a volunteer, you are involved in Campus Tours and FYI, or both! All volunteers will be trained, receive a **free shirt** for volunteering, reference letters, and have loads of fun in the process! Volunteering with Campus Ambassadors doesn't require a considerable time commitment and it's a great way to get a reference for future volunteer work or job applications.

The following application has 3 pages. Be sure to fill out the entire form and **attach a brief resume, as well as a schedule of classes for the upcoming Winter 2010 semester**. This can be obtained through Beartracks. Completed applications can be dropped off at the Centre for Student Development, Suite 0-26 SUB, across from the new SUBtitles or emailed to cac@su.ualberta.ca.
