# Applicable Bylaws, Rules, and Regulations

Rules & Regulations §1.4 (Reporting of Keys) Schedule of Fines and Penalties, provided as per Bylaw 2300 §48.

#### Facts

- 1. The nomination deadline for the March 2012 Students' Council and GFC General Election was 17:00 on Tuesday, March 13, 2012. The nomination deadline was extended until Thursday, March 15, 2012 at 17:00 for several positions, including Science Students' Councillor.
- 2. The deadline to report keys as outlined both in the Schedule of Fines and Penalties and verbally at the mandatory candidates meeting was 17:00 on Wednesday, March 14, 2012. For candidate nominations received from the extended deadline, this was outlined via email to be Friday, March 16, 2012 at 17:00.
- 3. At 17:00 on Wednesday, March 14, 2012 the Chief Returning Officer had not yet received a report of keys from Navneet Khinda or Mario Babic.
- 4. At 17:00 on Friday, March 16, 2012 the Chief Returning Officer had not yet received a report of keys from Tyler Catena or Cory Hodgson.

## Ruling

- 1. All candidates and sides are required to read, understand, and comply with all Rules & Regulations and Bylaws and were informed as such in the nomination package and at the mandatory candidates meeting and/or via email (where applicable).
- 2. The schedule of fines and penalties clearly states that a Report of Keys must be submitted within twenty-four (24) hours of the nomination deadline. The reporting of keys is also outlined in the Rules & Regulations §1.4, which stipulates that candidates failing to report their keys by the deadline will be penalized.



- 3. The Schedule of Fines and Penalties affixed to the nomination package denotes that a punitive fine of \$10.00 will be levied against the contravening party.
- 4. All candidates in contravention will be levied a \$10.00 fine against their candidate budgets.

### Penalty

- 1. Navneet Khinda will be levied a fine of \$10.00.
- 2. Mario Babic (SC) will be levied a fine of \$10.00.
- 3. Mario Babic (GFC) will be levied a fine of \$10.00.
- 4. Tyler Catena will be levied a fine of \$10.00.
- 5. Cory Hodgson will be levied a fine of \$10.00.
