#### **New This Year**

Those of you who have held Council or faculty association positions in previous years will know that in the past, COFA and Council have held separate retreats, in March and May respectively. This year, the COFA and Students' Council retreats will be combined into one large, off-campus event.

Combining the events allows us to make the COFA retreat longer and more involved, increasing the value for faculty associations who attend and providing opportunities for relationship-building and inter-faculty collaboration early in the term.

Not much will change in the Students' Council programming, except that they will have a greater opportunity earlier on in their terms to connect with their faculty's student association, and those who are both a Councillor and a faculty association executive won't have to attend two separate retreats.

Also new this year is this registration package. Because this event is much larger than in the past, we need to get a sense of the number of people attending well in advance. Please return this registration package by the dates listed below if you wish to attend the retreat.

Because attendance is limited for faculty associations, those who are a Councillor and a faculty association executive should register as a Councillor. You will still be able to attend faculty association sessions at your discretion.

#### Session 'Streams'

The tentative schedule included here is based on both previous Council and COFA retreats. It is arranged as a series of concurrent sessions where one is geared towards Council and one is geared towards to student faculty associations, with some larger sessions meant for both.

Councillors and faculty association executives will be able to attend whichever session they like in blocks that offer more than one; in other words, you do not have to attend the 'stream' that is for your organization.

You do not need to register for specific sessions. Registering for the whole retreat guarantees you access to all sessions.
