MOYAN: Recognised that ARRC focuses on relationship building between Aboriginals and non-Aboriginals.

DHILLON: Confirmed that she finished research concerning voting policies for ARRC.

MOYAN: Determined to collect information for the meeting days, times, and contact information for ASC.

DHILLON: Confirmed that the SU Marketing Department will create an infographic of the Guide for release on ASC and SU social media.

DIXON: Offered her support doing research for any of the Guide sections.

MOYAN: Determined to investigate how the Committee can advance the ARRC Recommendations. Directed Committee members to review and identify Recommendations they feel they can promote in advance of the next meeting.

DIXON: Proposed that Moyan connect with Kristen Stoik, Manager of Administrative Services, to receive training on chairing meetings and SU governance.
