Identified that faculty associations signal their interest in renewing their fee units to the Vice-President Academic in Fall and the Committee reviews and approves referendum questions in January. Outlined that, to create or change a bylaw, the Committee will draft First Principles and send them to Council which, once approved, will be returned to the Committee to be drafted into Second Principles. Clarified that First Principles are a general review of a bylaw's objectives whereas the Second Principles will become a completed bylaw. Clarified that

councillors, in voting on a bylaw, must consider whether the bylaw' purpose is necessary and valid in First Principles and whether the bylaw matches First Principles in its Second Principles.

BOSE: Noted that the Committee and Council can exchange a bylaw multiple times in order to ensure it accords with the First Principles and the wishes of Council.

TAYLOR: Identified that the 2019-20 Committee must follow-up on a Discipline, Interpretation, and Enforcement Board ruling to clarify the procedure for creating a Dedicated Fee Unit.
