2021-13/1e Bylaw Progress Check-In

DHILLON: Has had two meetings regarding assigned bylaws. Is hoping to have the entire Bylaw 8000s series done by January 11th and is also hoping to do consultation regarding Bylaw 8000s with CoFA before the end of January. Will also take the Bylaw 8000s series to Audit, Finance and Fee Governance Committees for review.
