2021-16/3b Discussion of KAIROS Blanket Exercise

VILLOSO: The fee for an in-person exercise KAIROS Blanket Exercise will be 1400 dollars. If an elder is to be included at the event, it will cost an extra 300 dollars. As of right now, the KAIROS Blanket Exercise is being planned as an in-person event which will take place either in March or April. There are currently no online options for the KAIROS Blanket Exercise.

CAC only has 1100 dollars left in its budget to pay for the blanket exercise. As such, ARRC would need to contribute money to the KAIROS Blanket Exercise in order for CAC to host the event.

Because the CAC budget will not transfer to the next year, suggests using the entirety of CAC's 1100 dollars budget to help cover the cost of the KAIROS Blanket Exercise.

BEASELY: Would also like to exhaust the budget. To their understanding, KAIROS works better in-person. However, some councillors will continue to be online, which could pose issues for participation.

Wonders how those not in-person can be included. Further questions if this discussion should also occur at ARRC.

VILLOSO: Agrees that ARRC should be included. Further iterates that KAIROS is not currently offering options for online exercises. The biggest concern about an in-person KAIROS Blanket Exercise is COVID and what the COVID situation will look like in February and/or March.
