APPELLANT: Paul Reikie

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATION AND RESPONSE:

Mr. Reikie seeks an exception to Bylaw 100 Section 11e, which prohibits a Students' Union Councilor who has been expelled for missing more than five Students' Council meetings, or three consecutive meetings, from being re-elected or appointed to Council in the same year in which they were removed. Mr. Reikie believes an exception is in order due to his expulsion from Students' Council being the fault his proxy, the 87% voter support he received in the election, and his belief that he is the most qualified candidate.

DECISION:

While the D.I.E. Board is sympathetic to Mr. Reikie and the circumstances surrounding his expulsion from Students' Council, and subsequent ineligibility to be re-elected or appointed, the Board does not have the authority or power to grant anyone any exception to any bylaw for any reason. The authority and power of the D.I.E. Board is restricted to only interpreting and enforcing the legislation of the Students' Union. Since there are no grounds for deliberation, the D.I.E. Board refuses to hear the appeal.

The Discipline, Interpretation and Enforcement (D.I.E.)
