



What is the Reusable Dish Program?

The reusable dish program is an initiative facilitated by Sustain SU to encourage waste diversion, and promote Zero Waste culture.

The service provides University of Alberta Undergraduate and Graduate community members with dishes/cutlery for their events/meeting and washes them for free. Transportation of dishes/cutlery are not included.






Why use the Reusable Dish Program?

FINANCIAL: Eliminating single use disposable containers at Student Union Council meetings reduces costs associated with repetitive wasteful purchases.

SOCIAL: Supports Student Union organ: Sustain SU, promoting a stronger sense of unity between student union bodies, and promotes the use of reusable dishes in other student groups by example.

INSTITUTIONAL: Make a statement that the University of Alberta is committed to waste reduction, and sustainability in general by fostering a culture of Zero Waste on campus.
