# University

### **Protest**

As you all know, there was a protest on Friday April 6 where hundreds of students, staff, and faculty braced the -25 weather to stand in opposition to the recently passed budget by the University of Alberta, Board of Governors. Given that the concerns from the campus community continue to be ignored by senior administration, we now call on the Government of Alberta to not accept the budget presented by the University.

Although another meeting of the Board of Governors has not been called, I did sit in on a teleconference which was intended to update the Board of the "situation" at the University. I have a Board Finance and Property Committee meeting on April 18.
