I hope you all are doing well. Below you will find an update of what I've been up to over the past two weeks.

### **Festival of Teaching and Learning**

The Festival of Teaching and Learning is an annual event where all members of the University of Alberta's teaching and learning community can share, demonstrate, explore, and embody the plurality of approaches to university teaching to enhance our pedagogies and teaching and learning environments across our institution. The theme for the Festival will be (Re)Imagining Post Pandemic Pedagogies and a critical, creative, and effective reflection of where we've come from, where we are now, and where we are hoping to go and a teaching a learning community.

The Festival will be happening May 3-5.
