On Friday the 23rd, we held a meeting with our project architects, our internal project team and U of A Facilities and Operations. We went through the Design Development report

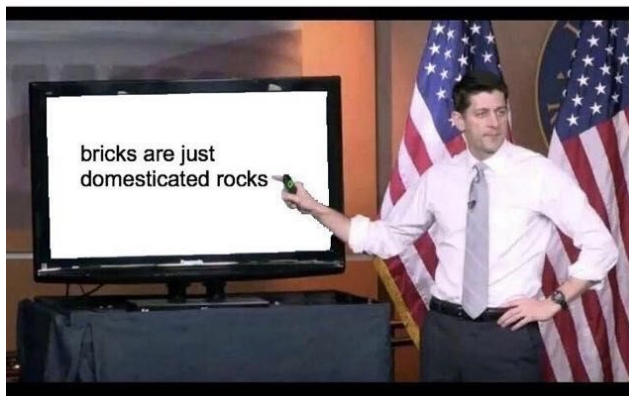
page by page and are beginning to prepare for presentation to FDC. We are currently sitting at 95% completion.
